Lesson 7: Student worksheet

The Rules

1. This game is suitable for 1 to 6 players.
2. There is one die which has six different images on it. A template of the die is provided on page 2 which can be cut out and glued together.
3. Each picture represents a 'story starter', as shown below:

 <p>Tell a story about carbon in living things</p>	 <p>Tell a story about how carbon causes changes in the weather</p>	 <p>Tell a story about what happens to carbon when it is burnt</p>
 <p>Tell a story about the different things you can do to stop carbon from entering the air</p>	 <p>Tell a story about what happens where there is too much carbon in the air</p>	 <p>Tell your favourite story about carbon</p>

4. There are no rules about the types of stories that can be told. The stories can be factual stories, creative stories, short stories, long stories, funny stories, verbal stories, written stories, stories told in pictures or words, stories acted out in role plays, etc.
5. Each player takes a turn to roll the die and tell a story about carbon related to the image that appears uppermost on the die.
6. Players can have one or more turns each depending on the amount of time available to play the game.
7. One possible extension to this game is for the players to decide on which story they like best and develop that story further for presentation to the rest of the class.
